BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND. 13 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Education 15 16 4-142. IN THIS SECTION, "INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS" MEANS TOOLS USED 17 FOR EDUCATIONAL INSTRUCTION, INCLUDING: 18 **(1)** 19 TEXTBOOKS AND OTHER READING MATERIALS; 20 **(2)** VIDEOS: 21 **(3) DIGITAL MATERIALS; AND**



- **(4)** 1 WEBSITES AND OTHER ONLINE APPLICATIONS. 2 (B) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL: **(1)** 3 ENSURE THAT EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY COMPLIES WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 7–112.2 OF THIS ARTICLE; AND 4 5 **(2)** ADOPT REASONABLE RULES THAT GOVERN THE TIMELY 6 PRODUCTION AND INSPECTION OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS THAT ARE NOT PUBLICLY AVAILABLE ON THE INTERNET. 7 7–112.2. 8 9 (A) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A STUDENT PRESENTATION. - 25 (IV) THE RULES ESTABLISHED BY THE COUNTY BOARD IN 26 ACCORDANCE WITH § 4–142 OF THIS ARTICLE FOR THE PRODUCTION AND 27 INSPECTION OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS THAT ARE NOT PUBLICLY AVAILABLE

- 2 (2) THE INFORMATION IN PARAGRAPH (1)(I) THROUGH (III) OF THIS
- 3 SUBSECTION SHALL BE ORGANIZED, AT A MINIMUM, BY SUBJECT AREA AND GRADE
- 4 LEVEL.
- 5 (3) A PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL:
- 6 (I) POST THE INFORMATION IN PARAGRAPH (1)(I) AND (II) OF
- 7 THIS SUBSECTION ON THE SCHOOL'S WEBSITE FOR AT LEAST 60 DAYS AFTER THE
- 8 END OF THE SCHOOL YEAR; AND
- 9 (II) RETAIN THE INFORMATION IN PARAGRAPH (1)(I) AND (II)
- 10 OF THIS SUBSECTION FOR 2 YEARS AFTER POSTING THE INFORMATION ON THE
- 11 WEBSITE.
- 12 (D) (1) THE CURRICULUM REQUIRED TO BE POSTED IN ACCORDANCE
- 13 WITH THIS SECTION SHALL, AT A MINIMUM:
- 14 (I) IDENTIFY INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS BY THE:
- 15 1. TITLE AND AUTHOR; OR
- 16 2. Organization or website associated with the
- 17 MATERIALS OR ACTIVITY:
- 18 (II) INCLUDE A BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE INSTRUCTIONAL
- 19 MATERIALS; AND
- 20 (III) IF PUBLICLY AVAILABLE ON THE INTERNET, INCLUDE:
- 21 1. A LINK TO THE INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS; OR
- 22 Information on how to request a copy of the
- 23 INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS.
- 24 (2) IF AN INDIVIDUAL COMPONENT OF INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS
- 25 USED THROUGHOUT THE CURRICULUM IS PRODUCED AS A SINGLE VOLUME, THAT
- 26 VOLUME SHALL BE LISTED ONLY ONCE IN THE CURRICULUM.
- 27 (E) THE DEPARTMENT, IN CONSULTATION WITH COUNTY BOARDS OF
- 28 EDUCATION, MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 2 $\,$ 1, 2023.
